



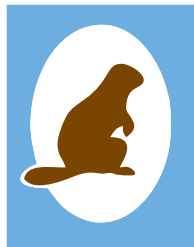

COURSE DESCRIPTION & PREREQUISITE

This course will provide you with the advanced skills necessary to plan and run Scouts Canada's youth programs in compliance with Program Standards and By-Laws Policies and Procedures.

Wood Badge II looks to increase Volunteer Support and Program Quality. Wood Badge II focuses on the practical application of the program facilitation and safety concepts learned in Wood Badge I, while introducing basic outdoor and Scouter support skills.

In addition you will get the opportunity to meet and network with other Scouters from across Ontario.

Candidates are required to attend all sessions on two weekends and complete home assignments to complete the course.

The following requirements must be met in order to qualify to attend Wood Badge Part II training;

1. Completed Wood Badge I for The Canadian Path (David Huestis Learning Centre Course ID 6536)
2. Completed or will complete the Outdoor Skills requirement
3. Have experience working with the section you are registering for
4. Are able to work with the section you are taking training for in between the 2 course weekend
5. Have identified two mentors in your local Scouting community
